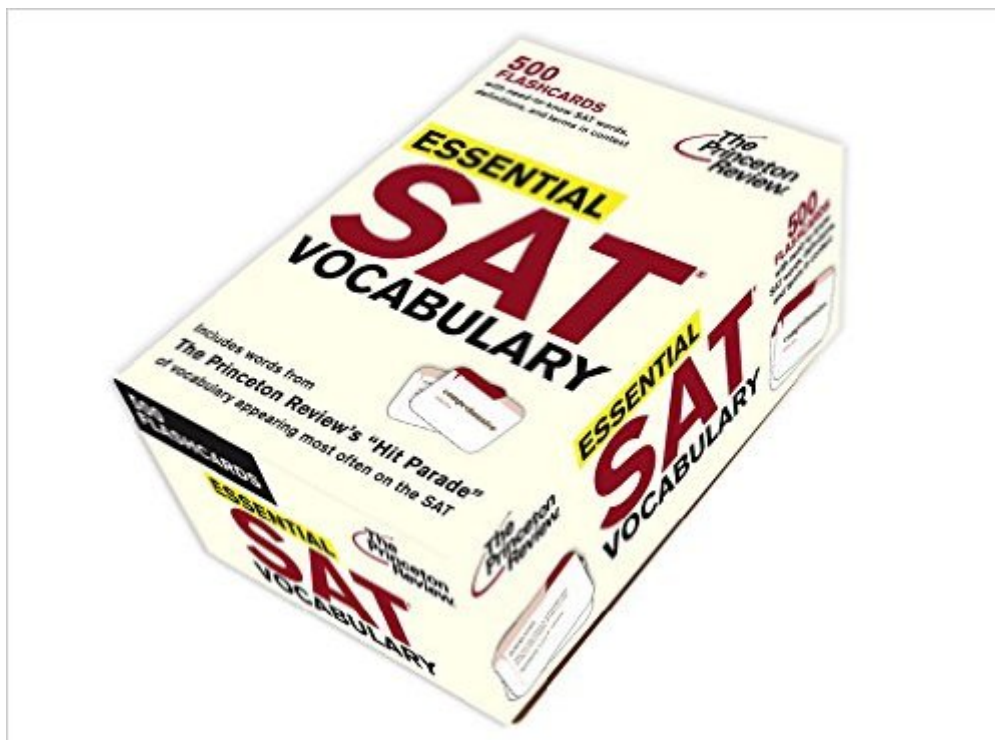

These cards are an easy way to boost your SAT-specific vocabulary. The flashcard format allows for quick repetition, more than with books in my opinion. I only wish they had pronunciation keys next to the definitions. I recommend these cards along with "Verbal Advantage" and a pocket dictionary for a lasting vocabulary increase. Daily reading, however, is still your best bet for a lifelong and effective vocabulary. These cards are just tools to speed up the process.

This set of cards can be very helpful if you are preparing for the SAT and your vocabulary bank needs more work. However, the effect of these study cards will vary greatly from person to person,

as this set contains some words that are used in everyday language and I really would not consider them to be "SAT vocabulary". If you already have a very good knowledge of SAT vocabulary, then you should look elsewhere. If you need work and need to learn SAT vocabulary quick, buying this will give you an easy and effective tool to the understanding of the basic words found in the SAT. By no means will this completely prepare you for EVERY word you will see on the SAT however, and if that was your goal, then you should complement this with more vocab to study.

I'm an SAT tutor, and I recommend this product for most of my students. It's helpful not just for the Sentence Completions, but for the whole Critical Reading section- many of these words show up in the long passages and the corresponding questions. It's true that students could make their own flashcards, but very few students are diligent enough to do that. This box gives them a huge number of useful words to learn, and having a sturdy box and dividers is invaluable to keep things organized. It's priced very reasonably for the quality you get. What keeps it from getting 5 stars? No pronunciation key for the words, and the definitions could be simpler.

I bought the Essential SAT Vocabulary Cards for my son and am pleased to say that he is very confident about taking the SAT. He has added some very valuable words to his vocabulary. Excellent!

These SAT Cards are always helpful, especially if you are a non-native speaker. I registered for the May SAT just to become more familiar with the question style, the only thing I did before the exam was to study flash cards. Since I had only one week and I was very tired of pulling all nighters for my exams, I studied 200 flashcards only. But even that made me feel confident and I got 620 or something between 600-650, I can't remember exactly. I say 'I highly recommend this to everyone'.

These cards are fun, easy to use cards with the Princeton Review Vocabulary I have found in numerous SAT preparation books. The flip-open box features a nice way to keep track of how many cards you learned. 30 empty cards can be used to fill in words not in the set. I already knew about 60-70% of the words, but it was expected as the words are from the Princeton Review books, which were fairly easy. Overall, a nice way to refresh up on vocabulary before the SATs.

Essential SAT vocabulary of 500 flashcards, is the best way to enhance your vocabulary on the SAT test. The words available in this box set, contains words I constantly see throughout the test;

on the vocabulary section and in many of the reading passages. These words focus on the overwhelming amount of words they say to study. This product helps boost your score, it also makes studying these words easier. Each flashcard has the vocabulary word in bold on the front side with the parts of speech (e.g. adjective, noun, or verb). If you flip the flashcard to the back side: it includes the definition, the word used in a sentence, and even a synonym. On the outside of the box, there are milestone markings that show a scale of how many words you've succeeded to study. This helps inspire you to move forward and it helps pace your target goals. It also includes 50 blank flash cards that can be used to fill in any of the terms you feel you need to study. Altogether, from the way the Princeton Review sets up the words, to the way the box is designed, they make it one hundred percent efficient and understandable to use. I highly recommend this box set; Essential SAT vocabulary says it all!!

These cards have very basic English vocab words like "adept" and "predecessor". I use them with a 12-year-old girl I tutor. So far, we haven't run across any words that she already knows. Studying with flashcards is a good activity for her. We can quickly run through a few cards as a break from other tutoring activities. I can't give 5 stars, because sometimes the definitions on the cards are too advanced and use words of equal or greater difficulty, e.g. using "transitory" to define "transient". When teaching someone with a rudimentary vocabulary, I'd prefer to have definitions that use simple words. The cards are somewhat flimsy and could bend or tear easily. Use with care, and store them in the box. The box does come with a nice divider to place between the words you've learned and the rest of the set. It also has quite a few blank cards for adding your own vocab words. Each card does include a sentence for the word that helps put its use in context as well as a couple of synonyms. Overall, these were a good buy. I would recommend them for middle school students and their parents and teachers. I am looking for something more advanced to recommend to my high school students.
