

As both an Occupational Therapist working with adults and an ex-wife of a person diagnosed with several personality disorders, I have found this book (though expensive) to be an amazing reference. It's EASY to read for the lay-person as well as very informative for the professional. The examples of conversations between those who have a personality disorder and their family members, friends, coworkers, etc seemed to be taken exactly from my experiences and friends experiences who have been in contact/relations with people "diagnosed" with these difficulties. I recommend reading at least the beginning section and the end and then looking at a more specific "diagnosis". His explanations and resources were a huge help to me. After 8 years of divorce and an additional 10 years of marriage, I finally began to understand what my therapists had been telling me all along - my ex-husband had a toxic influence of my life and the life of our children. The authors ability to describe, rationalize and assist in these "disorders" was exceptional. His level of compassion in a non-judgmental way was refreshing. He not only explains the "science" behind the disorder but also how best you, as a family member / friend / treating professional, can interact with said person in a healthy manner for everyone involved. My level of compassion and understanding of my difficulties in coming to terms with the emotionally confusion relationship with my ex-husband rose exponentially. I went from not truly grasping why he "was not the person I married" to understanding that these feelings were (are) normal. Why he bounced from relationship to relationship with no apparent concern for anyone involved.
