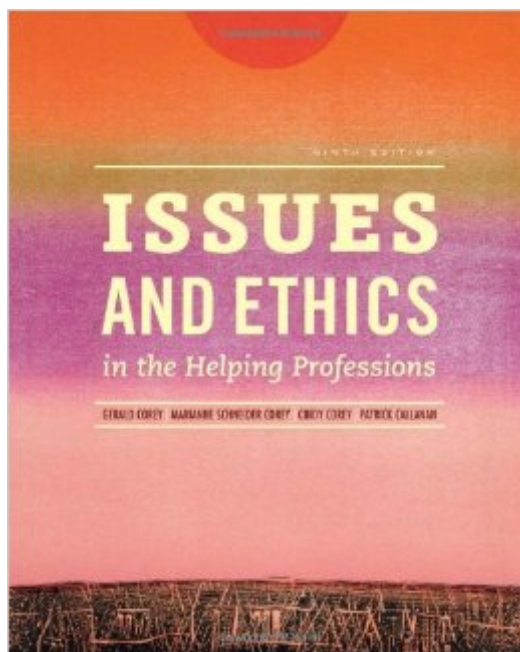


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Issues And Ethics In The Helping Professions (Book Only)
